Dear Parents/Guardians,

We wanted to inform you that [Child's Name] has been confirmed to have head lice. While this can feel concerning, please know that lice are a common occurrence among school-aged children and **are not a sign of poor hygiene or uncleanness.**

### Important Facts About Lice:

- Lice spreads through **direct head-to-head contact**, not from the home environment, furniture, or pets.
- Lice do **not** live for long off the human head, so they are not “living in your house.”
- If one person in the household has lice, **it is important to check everyone** to prevent re-exposure
- Over-the-counter or at-home treatments are not always effective, and lice may persist if all live bugs and eggs are not completely removed.

### What to Do Next:

1. **Check every member of your household** carefully (using a professional grade nit comb like the “terminator comb” is best) for live lice and eggs (nits)
2. Consider **professional lice removal** for thorough and accurate treatment.
3. Follow-up checks are essential, even after treatment, to ensure all lice and nits have been eliminated.
4. To prevent your child from getting lice, keep their hair up in buns and braids.
